- ❖ Clean their plate and glass.
- ❖ Laying the table.
- ❖ Folding mats and clothes.
- ❖ Arranging their toy shelf.
- ❖ Learning to wear shoes and socks.
- ❖ Sharpening the pencils.
- ❖ Learning how to zip their school bag and their uniform.(shorts)
- ❖ Making their beds.

Good manners and good habits are lifelong assets and they should be practiced until they become habit.
